Report Social Media and Christian Science

The Texas Committee on Publication, media and legislative representative for Christian Science, Keith Wommack, supported by three people from the Committee office in Boston who work with those in the field, visited First Church the evening of June 25. They spoke to members and attendees interested in using social media to help support the Committee on Publication, whose work was established by Mary Baker Eddy in Article XXXIII of The Manual of the Mother Church. They gave an inspiring, informative presentation about the background and the present, focused work changing the thought of health care, by handling impositions on the public with regard to Christian Science.

Without using Christian Science jargon and proselytizing, the manager of the Committee of Publication, with State and Assistant Committees are finding receptivity of media outlets to publish their articles on the changing thought of health professionals that show how consciousness affects health. They cite research and experiences of medical practitioners that open thought to be receptive to what Christian Science has to offer.
